# 72<sup>nd</sup> District Funding Opportunity for Local Nonprofits.

Representative Gregg Johnson has secured \$500,000 in state funding to support operational expenses for nonprofit organizations actively serving communities within the 72nd Illinois House District.

These funds, administered through the Moline Regional Community Foundation (MRCF), will prioritize organizations doing direct work in the following focus areas:
